Programme Duration

This QQI/FETAC Level 5 minor award is delivered through blended learning with 24 hours direct contact and 26 hours indirect.

The direct contact aspect is classroom based while the indirect is delivered through pre course work, study time, practice and reflection time. Pre course work is comprised of a home study component which covers the more theoretical aspects of the programme. The more practical aspects including skills development are addressed during the direct contact sessions.

Programme Certification

On successful completion of the course, candidates will receive a QQI/FETAC Level 5 Award in Occupational First Aid 5N1207.

Learner Assessment

To achieve certification, learners will undertake a skills demonstration and an examination is required to be completed, using a short answer format.

Learner Progression

Learners who successfully complete the programme may use the associated credits towards a QQI/FETAC Level 5 Certificate in Security Studies 5M2110.



Entry Requirements

No previous experience is necessary. Although some equivalent qualifications or relevant life experiences are desirable.

Participants are required to bring the following on the training day:

- Their PPS number (for course documentation).
- Two recent personal passport size photographs. (These photographs must have been taken within the last twelve months, and participant's names must be printed on the back).
- A photocopy or scan of participant's ID such as Driving Licence or Passport.
